12 IDEAS FOR MAKING CHRISTMAS MEMORABLE

- 1. Mail a postcard to the surrounding community
- 2. Print invites for your congregation to handout to family and friends
- 3. Decorate the lobby, stage, and Kids Zone to create multiple photo ops
- 4. Plan a Christmas cookie exchange
- 5. Use the pre-made provided social media posts from series resources and post on your
- Instagram and Facebook pages to create excitement and engagement.
- 6. Host a family movie night with popcorn, cookies, and hot cocoa
- 7. Prepare the children's ministry to sing a special Christmas song
- 8. Plan a candlelight Christmas Eve service and sing Christmas carols
- 9. Give a special Christmas offering to local initiatives
- 10. Dress up your welcome team or have an ugly sweater Sunday
- 11. Have a family share a short testimony/story on video or live on Sunday
- 12. Host a Christmas bake-off and/or Tree lighting and decorating night


COMMUNICATIONTS TIPS & REMINDERS

- Keep your communication clear and simple dates, service times, address, website. Don't miss the basics!
- Make sure your website is up to date. People will visit your website before they visit the church. Current information and photos will make a great first impression.
- Postcards are an effective way to invite thousands of people to church. Postcards have a long shelf life, so be sure to get them out early.
- Facebook ads are an inexpensive way to promote your services. Choose a great photo of your people, write a short, friendly invite, and link to your website for more information.
- Assign someone to take photos and/or video of your service. Not only can you share the photos and videos online to celebrate, but it also gives you updated pictures for your website and invites next year!
- Remember to update your website after Christmas. Change service times back to regular times, remove Christmas graphics and outdated events. Add a new homepage photo from your Christmas services! (Email updates to website@newlifechicago.org)

WEEK 1 - OCTOBER 30
