### Intro:

Addressing mental exhaustion – if we are going to run the race, we need to be able to identify when we are tired.

- 1. Observation
  - a. Moral failure is led by being too tired for too long.
  - <u>The different levels</u>

Tired – treatable

Exhausted – if you don't stop you won't make it. Moral failure/ You Quit – Drained and hopeless.

### <u>3 Patterns of Pastors Leading Large Churchs</u>

1. No Hobby

a. Solution: Get a hobby (family is not a hobby) "If you work your mind you should rest with your hands, if you work with your hands then you should rest with your mind." - Rick Warren

- 2. No real Friends
  - a. You need friends who are in your business and who love you.
  - b. When you are around people you like... they fill
    - you...
- 3. No Local Accountability
  - a. They had accountability... but they were not IN your life. They didn't know about your marriage, your friendships, your ministry.

Have local elders speak into the church, your family, and different ministries.

(If your "drain" list is longer than your "fill" list, then you need to change something.)

- 1. Sunday Experience
  - a. Evangelistic service
  - b. What is your faith goal? Are you challenging people?
  - c. Big Sundays/ Invite Culture
- 2. Life Groups
  - a. Discipleship/relationships
  - b. Over 50% increase in Life Groups
  - c. "Do you have an apprentice?"
  - d. Are you present for your life groups?
  - e. How many apprentices do you have for those groups?
- 3. Next Gen
  - a. Student Ministry
  - b. Kids <u>Quality and safe</u>
  - c. Youth Quality and safe
  - d. Young adults
- 4. Compassion

- a. Create an area of ministry that ministers to people outside the walls of your location.
  - i. Pick three areas.
  - ii. Push for others to get involved.
- b. If compassion is not a part of your Next Gen ministry, then they will leave.
- c. Celebrate what you are doing!
- d. Partnership opportunity with Pastor Mike or Abel.
