

- 77% of pastors say developing leaders and volunteers is a ministry need they need to give attention to or invest time in.
- 55% of pastors say they find avoiding overcommitment and overwork challenging.
- 51% of pastors say time management is an aspect of their personal life that needs attention.
- 63% of pastors say they face stress in ministry.



- Use a calendar and to-do list
- Have a scheduled weekly review/planning time
- Put the "big rocks" in first
- Break big projects into smaller tasks, then schedule when and how to get things done
